

ALCOHOL/BREATHALYZER

The West Islip Union Free School District is committed to discouraging and eliminating use of alcohol by students attending instruction or any other school functions or activities. Therefore, any student for whom there is a reasonable suspicion of the use of alcohol before or during the school day, prior to or during an extra-curricular, inter-scholastic, or other school-related function, whether conducted on or away from school property, may be required to submit to a breathalyzer test.

This policy shall be implemented in accordance with administrative regulations adopted for that purpose. It is not the purpose of this policy to conduct random testing of students.

The Board of Education and administration intend to have this breathalyzer policy serve as a deterrent to students attending school or school functions from consuming alcohol.
