<b>LEVEL</b>	<b>ASSIGNMENT</b>	<b>ACTIVITIES</b> <i>THESE ACTIVITIES WILL BE ASSIGNED IN SEPTEMBER BY CLASSROOM TEACHERS, WHO WILL GUIDE STUDENTS' WORK.</i>
<b>Elementary Entering Grades K-3</b>	<b>Read two books OR Participate in the Summer Reading Club at the West Islip Public Library (The Library will provide evidence of participation that students may give to their teachers.)</b>	<b>Book Review</b> Students will draw a picture of something from one of the books they read. Students who are able, will be asked to write a few sentences stating what the book is about.  <i>*Book Share Day</i>
<b>Elementary Entering Grades 4-5</b>	<b>Read two books OR Participate in the Summer Reading Club at the West Islip Public Library (The Library will provide evidence of participation that students may give to their teachers.)</b>	<b>Book Review</b> Students will write a review of one of the books they read and will also be asked to rate the book.  <i>*Book Share Day</i>
<b>Middle School Entering Grade 6</b>	<i>Loser</i> by Jerry Spinelli (This book will be distributed to students.)  <b>*Read a second title of your choice!</b>	<b>Note:</b> Teachers will devise appropriate assignments for this title at the beginning of the school year, as part of the middle schools' Bullying Program.  <b>BOOK REVIEW</b> Students will write a summary or a journal entry in which they react to a character, conflict, or event, in the story they chose <u>independently</u> .  <i>*BOOK SHARE DAY</i>
